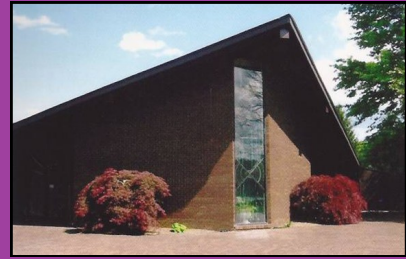

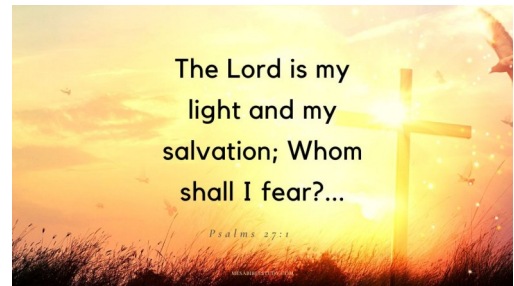
OUR MISSION STATEMENT

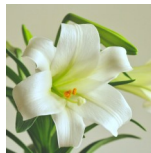
